Morgan Davison began her bassoon studies at the age of ten with Harvey Fleet, in Denver, Colorado. She has studied with fellow Moosmann Artists Roger Soren, in Denver, and also Martin Kuuskmann, both in Seattle and in Arosa, Switzerland.

She is a graduate of Interlochen Arts Academy, and now attends Manhattan School of Music, where she studies with Kim Laskowski, associate principal bassoon of the New York Philharmonic.

She has won many awards, including the Senior Division at the Asian Double Reed Association International Competition in Taiwan, and Semifinalist in the prestigious Fischhoff Chamber Competition with her quintet from Interlochen. She is a two-time winner in the National YoungArts competition, and performed a solo in New York City with them. In the fall of 2015 Morgan was recorded live on NPR's "From the Top." She was a winner of the Young Musician's Foundation of Colorado for 2015-16.

She plays on a Moosmann 222E model bassoon, and loves it!
